

**NOTICE OF CLASS ACTION  
AUTHORIZED BY THE COURT**

## **You financed a purchase at The Brick? You may be entitled to receive some money**

This notice concerns an agreement concluded in the class action against The Brick, regarding the annual fees of \$35 charged for its “Buy Now, Pay Later” financing plans.

The Brick will pay an amount of more than 1.9 million dollars, which will be distributed if the Court approves the agreement. If you qualify, you may receive a payment, file a claim form, contest the agreement or opt out from the class action.

### **Who is a member?**

**You are a class member if, before May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010:**

- You purchased a good or a service from The Brick in Québec and you subscribed to a “Buy Now, Pay Later” financing plan.

AND

- You paid annual fees.

### **What could you obtain?**

If the agreement is approved by the Court, you might obtain the refund of the annual fees that you were charged.

### **What must you do?**

That depends on the date when you subscribed to the financing plan.

- If you subscribed to the financing plan before May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009, there is nothing for you to do. You will be refunded directly by The Brick.

- If you subscribed to the financing plan **between May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009 and April 30, 2010, you must complete the claim form** which The Brick will send you.

### **What can you do if you do not agree?**

#### **You may contest the agreement:**

To contest it, you must write to the Court supervising the class action and explain why you believe that it should not approve the agreement. The deadline for contesting the agreement is **November 20, 2012**.

#### **You may opt out of the class action:**

To opt out, you must notify the Clerk of the Superior Court in writing, by providing the following information:

- the file number: 500-06-000485-090;
- your full name, address and telephone number;
- your statement: I am a member of the class and I wish to opt out of the class action;
- your signature.

You must send your letter by registered or certified mail **before November 20, 2012** to the following address:

### **What will happen next?**

The Court will hold a hearing to decide whether it should approve the agreement. You may attend and request to give your opinion at the hearing, which will take place in Montreal on **November 27, 2012**.
